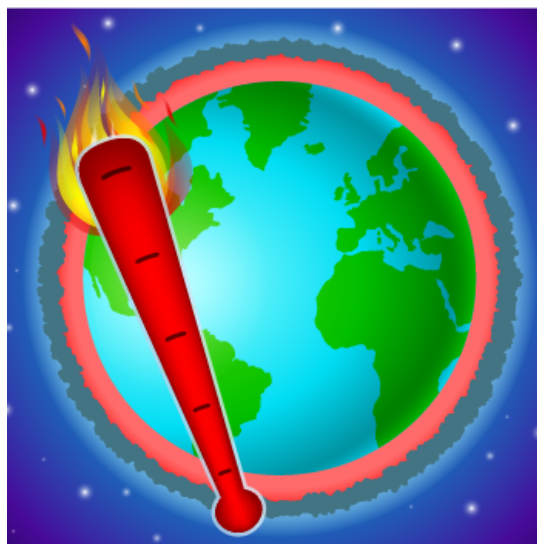
Exercise 1
